



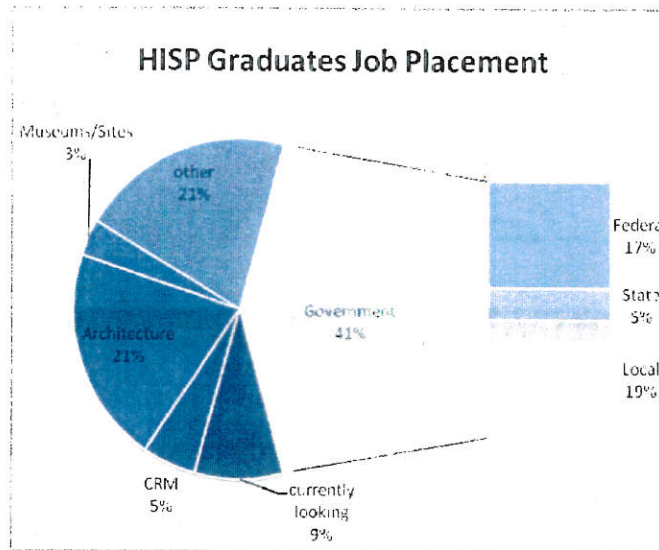

(as of Fall 2012)

- Since we graduated the first master's degree student in 2003, UMD School of Architecture, Planning, and Preservation has graduated 67 MHP students.
- The UMD historic preservation program was created by an interdisciplinary group including history, architecture, planning, anthropology, and American studies to serve the field's need for generalists to mediate between specialists such as conservators, designers, and historians. Coursework balances academic research with professional training in documentation, policy, and interpretation to prepare students to participate in the many aspects of contemporary preservation practice.
- Reflecting that diverse approach, UMD alumni work in a variety of fields, including government at all levels, cultural resources management and architecture firms, museums and historic sites, as well as other related non-profits.
- Nearly half of our master's students are working in government jobs ranging from the National Park Service, the State Historic Preservation Office in North Carolina and Massachusetts, and the City Planning Department of Gaithersburg, MD.
- UMD students are working in preservation jobs across the country and internationally as well.
