The Community Change Grants support comprehensive community, place-based approaches to addressing environmental and climate injustices for communities facing legacy pollution, climate change, and persistent disinvestment. These concentrated local investments fund community-driven, changemaking projects that center collaborative efforts for healthier, safer, and more prosperous communities.

We deliver training and technical assistance to increase the capacity of underserved, overburdened, and capacity-constrained communities in the Mid-Atlantic to access, deploy, and manage funding to address environmental and energy justice.

Two Funding Tracks

Track 1: Community-Driven Investments for Change (150 awards of \$10 to \$20 million):
Projects focusing on multifaceted Climate Action and Pollution Reduction Strategies to meaningfully improve the environmental, climate, and resilience conditions affecting disadvantaged communities.

Track 2: Meaningful Engagement for Equitable Governance (20 awards of \$1 to \$3 million):
Projects facilitating the engagement of disadvantaged communities in governmental decision-making to advance environmental solutions.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Applicants are strongly encouraged to apply early. **Deadline to submit is November 21, 2024.**
