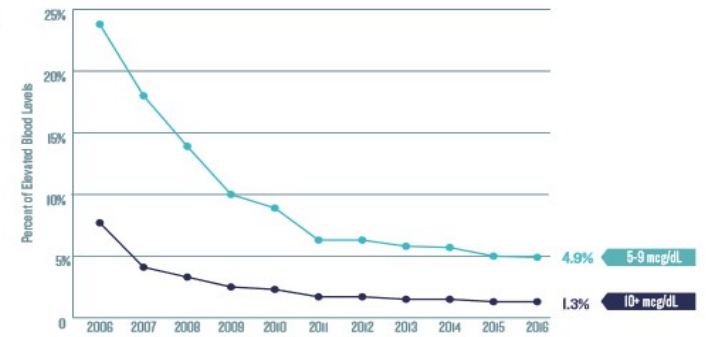


CHILD LEAD EXPOSURE

In 2016, approximately 6.2 percent of tested children (ages five and under) had newly-identified blood lead levels higher than the CDC-designated "reference level" of 5 mcg/dl, the lowest incidence in the last decade. Childhood lead poisoning is highest in the lowest-income neighborhoods that have older housing.

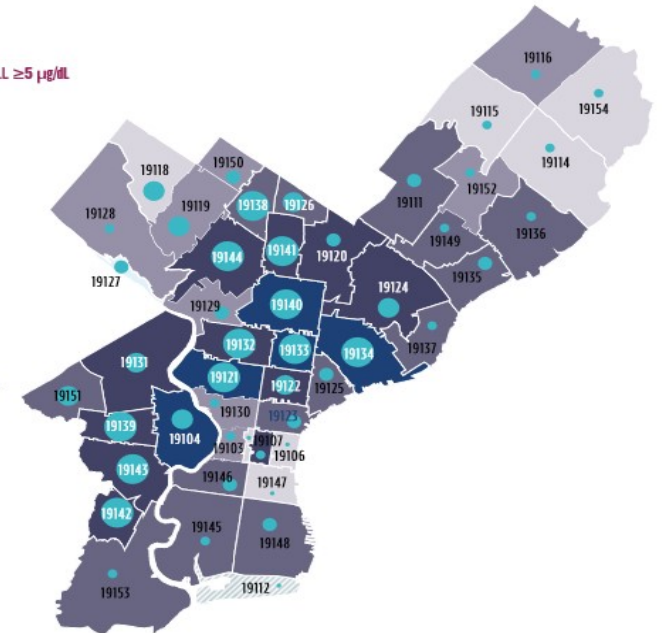
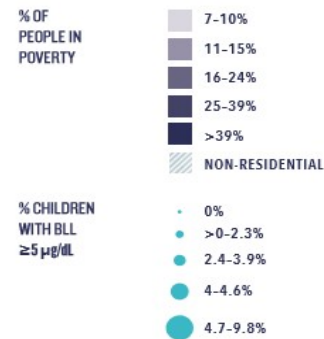

EPA RRP Lead Safety Certification Training **It's The Law!**

To become a certified renovator, individuals must successfully complete an 8 hour initial course and successfully complete an exam. As of April 2010, Federal law – requires contractors to become EPA Lead Certified Renovators.

The EPA's Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) Final Rule (40 CFR 745) requires that renovations conducted for compensation in pre-1978 homes and child occupied facilities must be performed by certified firms using certified renovators.

This includes: General Contractors, HVAC, Painters, Plumbers, Carpenter, Electricians, Window & Door Replacers, Roofers and Property Managers.

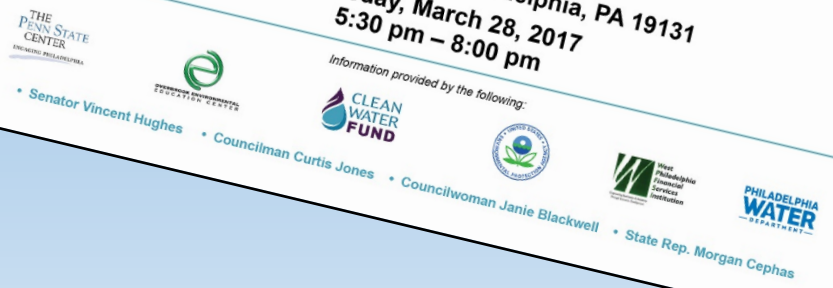
